CRITERIA

CITIZEN OF THE YEAR

Or, in the course of their professional activity, have brought outstanding/remarkable attention to the community on a provincial, national or international basis.

YOUTH VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR

- Individuals must be 19 years of age or under as of December 31, 2018 and have performed their volunteer activity in the community.

BUSINESS OF THE YEAR

- Must be in business in the community
- Must use, but not restricted to, criteria listed below
- Will be judged on community involvement for the overall business or on a project/program basis.
- Must show commitment to the project/program (i.e. longevity of commitment, fundraising, etc.)
