**4 BOND STREET:** Enjoy this 1932 double brick bungalow in old Dundas. It has been totally renovated with open concept design, a spiral staircase and Cathedral ceilings. Enjoy the Mixed Media Art Gallery by Urban Chaos and Capture the Moment Photography.

**9 LITTLE JOHN ROAD:** This Trillium Award winning house was built in 1965. The Great Room's vaulted ceiling and wall of windows will showcase a live Christmas tree strung with over 2500 lights. Four other Christmas trees will be featured, decorated in different themes. Don't miss the charming Dickens Dept 56 Village in the family room!

**50 SOUTH STREET WEST:** A favourite returns to celebrate our 45<sup>th</sup> Tour! This 1847 family home was built in the Greek Revival Architecture Period and much of the original interior can be seen, including oak floors and built-in bedroom cupboards and bookshelves. The recently renovated kitchen blends with its wood burning fireplace and travertine floors. Enjoy five fireplaces ablaze and the Christmas music!

**32 TALLY HO DRIVE:** This original 1,000 sq. ft. home, built in 1952 by one of the Warren children (Warren Park), was purchased in 2007 and has been transformed into the existing 4,250 sq. ft. contemporary family home you will see. Entertainment areas are on multi-levels. Enjoy the Artwork and decorations collected from around the world.

**34 VICTORIA STREET:** Returning to live in Dundas, this owner found her dream home. Built in 1942, this English Cottage boasts its original floors and glass doors. Beautiful landscaping surrounds the home which is lovingly decorated for Christmas throughout, with the owners' own collections!
